## AFFIDAVIT OF SPONSORSHIP FOR AN F-1 STUDENT

### INSTRUCTIONS

This **Affidavit of Sponsorship** must be completed and signed by the individual who will be supporting the applicant (and dependents) financially during their study at Hillsborough Community College (HCC). **It must be accompanied by an official bank letter or statement attesting to the sponsor's financial status.** The name of the sponsor on this Affidavit must match the name of the account holder on the bank statement. This document must be dated within six months of the term the student plans to enroll at HCC.

U.S. immigration regulations require that an F-1 student has sufficient funds to pay all expenses as necessary to complete their program of study and to cover living expenses while they reside in the United States. **Applicants must provide evidence that specific funds are available to cover the first year of full-time study.**
